The First Future Pillars (Zambia) Charity Walk The Saints Way, Padstow to Fowey, Cornwall 7 July 2018

We are a UK charity feeding and educating vulnerable children/young adults in Kabwe, Zambia. Unlike most other charities the Trustees personally fund all UK costs. Every penny raised is sent to Zambia and subject to annual audit by Trustees. We pay all travel costs to ensure the children are at the heart of this charity.



To continue to support over 1,000 vulnerable children many of whom are orphans, we are delighted to invite you to conquer the Saints Way, an ancient route for Pilgrims from the North to South Coast of Cornwall. The whole route is a strenuous but achievable 30 miles in one long summer's day. If that is just too far then there is a half way option either in the morning or the afternoon/evening, only 15 miles! Bucketloads of lovely Cornish scenery, pubs, churches, ancient woodlands, country lanes, open fields, coastal views, viaducts, summer meadows. Complimentary Water and food provided en route at roughly 5 mile intervals, chicken or veggie lunch.
